

## Ultimate Hiking Packing Checklist

This hiking packing checklist applies mostly to multi-day treks where your sleeping and eating arrangements are taking care of separately. If you are camping, then you'll need to add food and other camping gear. We trek together as a couple, so while some items are unisex others are divided into specific gear for women and men.
